hellocentral

Fueled by an ambitious, genre-spanning take on modern alternative rock, and energetic yet emotional live performances, **hellocentral** has taken the Denver music scene by storm over the past two years.

Formed in late 2017 in Denver, CO by four life-long friends, hellocentral is the product of a culmination of influences, experiences, and a common passion for music. Compared to the likes of Brand New, Turnover, and Blink 182, hellocentral set out to create music that people can not only dance to, but connect with, blending dreamy indie rock elements with hard-hitting yet catchy pop punk choruses and melodies.

hellocentral released their debut self-titled EP in July of 2018 (which was self-recorded), and a string of local shows followed in the months after — adding a loyal base of fans along the way. The band gained buzz in early 2019 with the release of their lead single 'Temple', which was professionally recorded at Spot Studios in Lakewood. Soon after, the band played their first show of the year at Cervantes Other Side in Denver, and was later interviewed for a full-page feature in *LoHi Lifestyle Magazine's* April edition.

The band made headway in the summer of 2019 through the release of their single 'Carbon Fiber House', a spacey yet intense alternative rock anthem. A series of shows at well known venues followed, including Lost Lake, Your Mom's House, Walnut Room, and most recently, Marquis Theater, in direct support of Bury Mia. hellocentral is currently in the process of writing new music, and is looking to bring their energetic live show to some even larger venues over the coming months. Their next single, 'Love Child' is set to release at the end of August.
